The Work Experience Provider agrees to abide by the Discipline and Grievance Procedures as laid down by W&DFITS and shall advise W&DFITS of all and any actions taken under these Procedures.

The Work Experience Provider further agrees that no Learner shall have their training terminated or be dismissed without the first advising W&DFITS of their intended action.

Attendance at W&DFITS is necessary on a regular planned basis to ensure the underpinning knowledge and Key Skills training is ongoing so that each learner can achieve their W&DFITS will inform the Work Experience Provider of the pattern of attendance required by the Learner and the Work Experience Provider must release to attend. In exceptional circumstances, Learners may be allowed to stay with the Work Experience Provider but only after agreement has been obtained from W&DFITS. Failure to reach agreement may result in the Work Experience Provider being in breach of the Contract.

Hours of work whether on placement or at W&DFITS shall be a minimum of 30 per week excluding breaks. Although workers and young people are exempt from the working time limits imposed by the Working Time regulations the Work Experience Provider and W&DFITS shall agree a reasonable number of work hours and appropriate periods away from the boat.
